If a punctual start is made it will be possible to walk the 3/4 mile circuit through the scenic reserve upon arrival. Tea will be provided but bring your own milk, sugar, steak etc. Don't forget your song books.

BARNEY PORTALS TRIP - 14th - 16th April - Upper and Lower Portals, Mt. Barney area - Leader Margaret Kennedy.

Those participating in this venture should be prepared to walk a short distance on Friday night (approximately 3/4 mile on downhill dirt road) so don't forget your torches. It is proposed during this weekend to explore the upper reaches of Mt. Barney Creek which flows behind Mt. Barney. Although there won't be a great deal done, as regards climbing, there will certainly be plenty besides, to interest all, in this area. Just to see Mt. Barney Creek crashing and tumbling over giant granite boulders, cascading over huge slabs of rock, would in itself make the trip worthwhile. The creek is dotted with fine swimming holes, which should prove particularly

inviting. Dominating the whole scene is the great mass of Barney, with Leaning Peak standing out sentinel-like against the sky. Here is scenery on a grand and rugged scale. Don't miss it!

As this trip is in the nature of a "semi-throughwalk" although certainly not a hard one, any members wishing to go who may not have the necessary pack should contact the Equipment Officer so that some arrangements can be made.
