While out walking, please, for safety sake, observe the following basic rules.

- (1) Do not at any time wander away from the main party.
(If you wish to leave the party tell the leader)
- (2) Do not walk or stand too close to the edge of drop-offs.
- (3) Do not throw stones, rocks, or other missiles over the sides of mountains. (This is a bad habit to develop and could cause very serious accidents). Also watch those loose rocks when climbing.
- (4) When around the Camp-fire, exercise extreme care; a small mistake here could mean a very nasty burn. Do not use rocks from creek beds in or around the fire as they could explode.
- (5) When using Knives, Machetes and other sharp instruments, be cautious. Also when packing these items, make sure they are adequately covered.

All these suggestions bring to mind the question of First Aid. How many of our Members know anything about First Aid? Unfortunately, far too few!

It is essential that each and every member know a little about First Aid, or, better still, that they hold a First Aid Certificate. All Members (with or without a First Aid Certificate) should carry an adequate First Aid Kit whilst out walking. By adequate is meant -

SNAKE BITE KIT - (1 Tourniquet (Boot lace)
(1 Gem Razor Blade)

1 Triangular Bandage	Small amt. cotton wool
12 Band Aids	(in plastic)
1 Reel Sticking Plaster	1 Tube Savlon cream
	12 Disprin or Asprin Tabs.
	Needle; 2 Safety Pins
	Pair of tweezers
